Smart Business Grants

Ealing Council smart business grants scheme offers free impartial advice and grant funding for Ealing businesses to help reduce costs, increase efficiency and environmental performance.

Business support: A free one hour survey is offered by one of the business advisors to identify ways of reducing costs of lighting, heating, water and waste. Your business could be eligible for a grant support package of up to 50% of project costs – with the remaining 50% to be funded by your business.

The fund is typically used to fund heating equipment, machinery upgrades or improvements to insulation or lighting. Grants are limited, so register now at

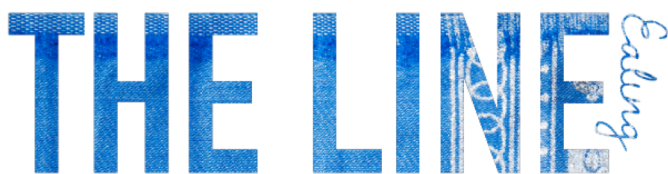

A free waste electrical and electronic collection has been arranged for 1 December 2016.

To book a free collection of any electrical / electronic items such as fridges, freezers, computers, small appliances, large appliances, wires, cables and plugs, IT and telecommunications equipment contact the team.

When recycled, the electrical equipment gets broken down and raw materials are recovered. Glass, copper and other rare materials are then used for re-manufacturing. Electrical waste is packed full of toxic chemicals. It's incredibly important (not to mention a legal requirement) that absolutely none of these ends up in general landfill where they can leak into the earth. So book your collection today:
